

SCREENING STATION

> Please review the following Screening Questions:

- Have you been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
- Have you had a temperature of 100.0 F or higher in the past 72 hours?
- Have you had any symptoms of COVID-19 in the past 72 hours?

Most common symptoms include:

- Fever
- Dry cough
- Tiredness

Less common symptoms:

- Aches and pains
- Sore throat
- Diarrhea
- Conjunctivitis
- Headache
- Loss of taste or smell
- A rash on skin, or discoloration of fingers or toes

Serious symptoms:

- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Chest pain or pressure
- Loss of speech or movement

> If you answer yes to any of these questions, visitation to our facility is not allowed at this time.

Please seek immediate medical attention if you develop serious symptoms.

> If you answer no to ALL of the Screening Questions:

- Step up to the Tablet and follow the instructions to undergo a temperature screening.
- Once temperature is read, present to the Information Desk to receive your Visitor Identification Sticker.
